**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Hill Top Prep's Annual Thrill on the Hill 5K to be held on May 19th, 2018.

Staff Traffic Committee approves the Hill Top Prep's Thrill on the Hill 5K on May 19, 2018.

2. Folding Stop Signs – During power outages at traffic light controlled intersections

Steve Chanenson has suggested folding stop signs for power outages in the Township. Public Works Field Leader Bill Cassidy states that this request holds many liability issues with the Township. Staff Traffic Committee states that no other complaints regarding this issue has been received by them. The Township already has an emergency plan in effect if street lights go out as a result of a loss of power. The folding stop signs are not required by the MUTD.

3. Parking concerns with Bryn Mawr Trust office building on Pembroke Avenue and surrounding streets

Staff Traffic Committee states the Codes Department met with the Bryn Mawr Trust and determined overflow parking was a temporary issue. Radnor parking authority

has removed the temporary no parking signs and no new complaints have been received.

4. Saint Katherine of Siena School is requesting to hold their annual 5K event on May 12, 2018 from 9am to 10am.

Staff Traffic Committee approves the Annual 5K event on May 12, 2018.

5. Kathy Agnew requests permission to hold the Annual 2018 Porch Fest

The Annual 2018 Porch Fest will take place on Saturday, September 15, 2018 from 11:45am-5pm. Rain date will be Saturday, September 22, 2018. Kathy Agnew requests to extend the Porch Fest to include up to the 400 block of Midland Avenue. She requests barricades, police and police car presence, and citizens police academy members to help assist with traffic. Staff Traffic Committee approves the request and this will go to the Board of Commissioners for final approval.

6. Commissioner John Nagle - Concern for truck traffic and speeding on Moore Avenue

Staff Traffic Committee states data indicates no speed issue on Moore Avenue. Recent truck activity on Moore Avenue was commercial asphalt truck company hired by Radnor Township. Staff Traffic Committee states Highway Patrol will continue to monitor truck traffic. Radnor Township Public Works Department is installing better signage to assist resident concerns.

7. Grace Smith of 250 N Aberdeen Ave requests a handicap parking space.

Ms. Smith sent email to Deputy Superintendent Chris Flanagan requesting handicap space. Highway Patrol Officer Pat Lacey did a site visit at this location. All documents have been obtained. Staff Traffic Committee approves the request for a handicap space in front of 250 N Aberdeen Avenue. Staff Traffic Committee stated that Ms. Smith is aware that this handicap space is available to the public and not primarily for her use. This will go before the Board of Commissioners for final approval.

8. Wheels of Wayne Road Closure – April 29, 2018

Staff Traffic Committee states the Wheels of Wayne road closure granted by PennDot.

9. Petition for Speed Bumps – Midland Avenue

Staff Traffic Committee states that this will be continued and discussed at the next Staff Traffic Committee Meeting of May 16, 2018 so that residents may attend.
