Radnor Township Recreation & Community Programming Department Announces Night at the Ball Park Event and Fireworks at Encke Park

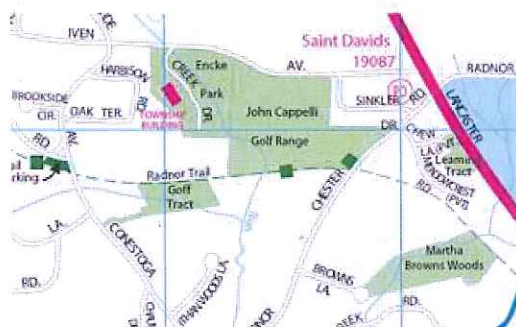
Dear Radnor Township Neighbors,

I would like to take an opportunity to tell you about an exciting evening event that is coming to **Encke Park on Wednesday, July 20th, known as the Night at the Ball Park & Fireworks Finale** (In the event of rain, the event will take place on Thursday, July 21st). This free outdoor community event, now in its fourth year, will begin at 6:00 PM with lots of activities and a live Philadelphia Phillies Baseball Game that will be shown on a big outdoor screen at approximately 8:10 PM on Encke Ball Field A, the field located along Iven Avenue. This event will feature, fun games, bounce houses, community businesses and organizations, a fundraiser cookout by Radnor Wayne Little League, and Fireworks that will begin at approximately 9:30 PM.

Live Phillies Game Begins at 8:10 PM – The live Phillies Game begins at 7:05 PM, but will be broadcasted upon darkness at approximately 8:10 PM; the broadcast will last approximately 2 hours. The game will be shown on a big screen with audio and visual equipment. We want you to be aware that lights and sound will be generated as a result of this event that is taking place within the park.

Fireworks Begin at 9:30 PM – Fireworks will blast off from the Cappelli Driving Range, located next to Encke Park. Fireworks will begin at 9:30 PM and will last approximately 15 minutes. In the event of rain, the fireworks time may be adjusted slightly. We want you to be aware that lights and sound will be generated as a result of the fireworks taking place within the park. Access to Cappelli Driving Range will be restricted on Wednesday, July 20th as we prepare for the fireworks.
