Good Afternoon Wheels of Wayne 2017 Participants!

Thank you for registering your car, truck, or motorcycle for the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Wheels of Wayne Event on next Sunday, April 30<sup>th</sup>! You are receiving this message because you have registered to participate in our event. We want to take an opportunity to communicate some important information that you should be aware of prior to next Sunday's Event. Please note you may receive this message more than one time as we want to ensure that everyone who has registered receives it!

- The Wheels of Wayne Event will take place on Sunday, April 30<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 to 4:00 PM, our rain date is scheduled for Sunday, May 7<sup>th</sup>. In the event of rescheduling the event due to inclement weather, you will receive an email message from the Recreation & Community Programming Department. You can also check our Wheels of Wayne page for information about the event by [clicking here](#).
- **We ask that you arrive at the event by 10:30 AM.** Volunteers will be there to assist you and help get you to a parking spot. If you are not able to allow your vehicle to idle for a long period of time please let us know by calling us right away so we can make special arrangements for your arrival. Please plan to be at the event until 4:00 PM – once you arrive and are parked, it will be very difficult to leave due to the large amount of other cars and vendors that will be at the event. If you need to leave early, please let us know right away and we will reserve a spot for you along West Avenue, where it will be easier for you to depart if you need to leave early. If you have a larger vehicle or any other special features that may require a bigger parking space, please let us know right away so we can appropriately assign you a space. If you would like to be parked next to a specific car, you must arrive and drive into the event at the same time in order for us to place you together and we will do our best to ensure this occurs! Due to our small event footprint, all cars will be parked together in the order in which they arrive.
- **All registered vehicles must enter the event area by traveling south on North Wayne Avenue, no exceptions – please see map below and attached.** There will be no access from Route 30/Lancaster Avenue or from West Avenue onto North Wayne Avenue. Barricades will be placed on North Wayne Avenue and will not be moved until 10:30 AM when vehicle registrant access is permitted. Starting at 10:30 AM, vehicles will be able to proceed into the event area by traveling south onto North Wayne Avenue and will be directed to a space. We recommend that you map out your route to the event ahead of time to ensure a smooth entrance to the event area. Larger vehicles, trucks, muscle vehicles, and all vehicles arriving late to the event will be showcased on West Avenue. Also, if space on North Wayne Avenue fills up, you will be asked to park on West Avenue. In addition to North Wayne Avenue, West Avenue is a vital part of our event footprint!

- **Once you are parked in your spot** – We recommend you keep all doors locked and closed when parked. Feel free to open your windows, hood, and trunk. If you want to bring chairs, please keep them to a minimum as space will not allow for tents, large tables, etc. for vehicle participants. Using small display tables for information you deem appropriate or for your dash plaque is acceptable. After you are parked, please visit the HUB area – see location identified by the checkered square on the attached map - to pick up your participation packet including your WOW Dash plaque and to check in. ***If you have not done so previously, please make sure to display your Dash Plaque on or near your vehicle. This is necessary in order for your vehicle to be judged.*** Radnor Township employees and volunteers will be available to assist you with any questions at the HUB. If you have any questions during the event, please stop by the HUB and we would be happy to help you!
- **EARLY PACKET PICK UP!** We will be offering a packet-pick up Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup> at the Radnor Township Recreation & Community Programming Department office located at 301 Iven Avenue, Wayne between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM. Please stop by to pick up your materials. All pre-registered participants will receive a Wheels of Wayne t-shirt, license plate, and custom dash plaque!
- Please note - there will be one hand washing station located by the portable toilets for your use. See map attached for location.
