Here are some tips for Saturday night's event:

- Once you hear sirens starting around 4:00 PM and going approximately through 9:00 PM, have your child/ children ready at the bottom of your driveway or in the established meeting area (if applicable). We will do our best to be there as early as possible but Santa does have a lot of stops to make! We cannot give a prediction of the exact time Santa will arrive at your house because of the large amounts of participants.
- For families that are not registered, if the motorcade in on your street visiting other houses, you are able to sneak your gifts to the people in the "present vehicle". That vehicle will be trailing the fire engine (where Santa is located!). Please make sure the address is on the gifts as well as the child/children names so Santa knows who to give the present to!
- Do you live in an apartment? The fire engines will be making their way towards your apartment unit but
  please be on the lookout for the lights and sirens in case for some reason they are not able to get to your
  building to deliver the presents. Please see below for where you should meet Santa.

- If for some reason you are not home at the time of your delivery your packages will return with Santa to the Radnor Township Building (301 Iven Avenue, Wayne) - unless you have made a special request. You can come during our business hours of 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday-Friday) to pick up your packages.

- Please wait to approach any of the vehicles until they've come to a complete stop. This will help to ensure the safety of everyone participating!
