I am writing to inform you about the upcoming 3rd **Annual Truck Zoo** event **MOVED TO ITS RAIN DATE: Saturday, September 19th from 2:30 to 5:30 PM.** The Radnor Township Recreation & Community Programming Department, Radnor Memorial Library, and Villanova University have teamed up to deliver the **Truck Zoo Community Event**, a family-friendly event where kids can climb in and experience hands on real-life fire engines, police cars, Public Works trucks and other exciting vehicles to learn how they operate and what they are used for! Vehicles/attractions for this year include a Philadelphia tour trolley, College Hunks Hauling Junk dump truck, the Sweet & Sassy Limo, a Monster Tow Truck, an Eagles Fan vehicle, and our fantastic Helicopter Piñata! **The Helicopter Piñata is scheduled to land on the Radnor Middle School field and will disburse candy and trinkets for all children who are patiently waiting around the established perimeter!**

Combined activities with the Library will offer children's story times and educational craft projects that teach about vehicles and transportation, an age-appropriate introduction to everyday emergency services such as police and fire, entertainment, snacks, giveaways, area organizations, and more! **Truck Zoo** not only serves as an open house for the Radnor Memorial Library and introduces the community to all that their Children's Services Department provides, but is sure to be fun for all ages! This event is free for the community to attend!

I also want to inform you that there will be a road closure associated with this event – **South Wayne Avenue between School Lane & Runnymede Avenue.** Due to the footprint this event will entail, South Wayne Avenue will be closed between School Lane and Runnymede Avenue from 7:00 AM through 7:00 PM on the day of the event – *Saturday, September 19th*. The municipal parking lot and Radnor Middle parking lot, both along South Wayne Avenue, will be closed as well as they are being used for the event. Parking will be prohibited in this area during the closure and vehicles will be towed. Parking for members of the community will be available in the adjacent Wayne parking lots and areas – Bellevue Lot (AT&T Lot); West Avenue Parking Areas; North Wayne Lot; along Lancaster Avenue; and along North Wayne Avenue. Meter restrictions will be waived. Please see attached map of the event.
