Dear Valued Customer:

Every day, PECO is delivering innovation and advancing smart energy to provide safe, reliable, affordable, and clean energy and energy services for our customers. As part of our work, we will be upgrading and installing new equipment to enhance the local electric distribution system in your area.

This project is part of PECO's Reliability & Resiliency Plan to invest \$1.36 billion through 2025 on targeted reliability-focused infrastructure investments. These accelerated investments will help strengthen the local electric infrastructure to better withstand more frequent and damaging storms, deliver enhanced reliability for our customers, and enable the adoption of clean energy resources.

About the Project:

- More than \$500,000 will be invested to enhance the local electric distribution system for you and your neighbors Radnor Township.
- PECO recognizes that this area has seen a lot of outages. Therefore, we will be upgrading and installing new equipment in your area, including new utility poles, and aerial wire. This new wire is referred to as Hendrix cable. Hendrix cable is a more durable material that is more resistant to strikes making the system more durable and less prone to failure. The result is a much more reliable system.
- This project also will include tree trimming and tree removals to reduce the number of outages caused by trees and other vegetation.
 - o PECO works with certified arborists, employs professional foresters and adheres to national ANSI A300 standards when managing tree trimming and removal.
 - o The Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Department of Forestry, and the Arbor Day Foundation have certified PECO as a Tree Line USA? Utility in honor of our commitment to proper tree pruning, planting and education in our service area.
 - o In 2019-2020, PECO supported the planting of 17,250 trees throughout our service territory.
- While this project will have far reaching benefits, the majority of this work will occur along St. David's Avenue and Glenmary Road.
- Tree work is expected to begin in late June 2021 with construction to follow.
- Work will occur from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday with all work being performed by PECO or a qualified PECO contractor.
