DISCUSSION OF TOWNSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES OF TOWNSHIP TREES AND SIDEWALKS

TREE RESPONSIBILLITY BY ORDINANCE

§ 263-9. Street trees

 Maintenance of street trees. The cost and expenses of planting, pruning, maintaining, fertilizing, protecting and caring for street trees shall be borne by the Township unless the Township determines that a property owner is responsible.

BACKGROUND

- SHADE TREE RECOMMENDED IN THEIR 2019
 BUDGET PROPOSAL THAT THE TOWNSHIP INVEST
 OVER \$1M TOWARDS TREE MAINTENANCE AND PLANTING.
- THE ADMINSITRATION ADVISED THE BOARD DURING THE 2019 BUDGET PRESENTATION, WITH THE INPUT AND ADVICE FROM THE TOWNSHIP ARBORIST THAT WE ARE 25-30 YEARS BEHIND IN MAITNENANCE AND REPLANTING OF TREES THROUGHOUT RADNOR.
- THE ADMINSITRATION RECOMMENDED INVESTING \$2-3M PER YEAR FOR THE NEXT 25 YEARS TO GET CAUGHT UP IN THE MAINTENANCE AND REPLANTING OF TREES THROUGHOUT THE TOWNSHIP.

SIDEWALKS

- THERE ARE NUMEROUS SIDEWALKS
 THROUGHOUT THE TOWNSHIP WHICH HAVE
 BEEN BROKEN OR DAMAGED DUE TO THE
 TOWNSHIP TREES IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY AS
 DEFINED UNDER § 263-9. Street trees.
- OVER THE PAST SEVERAL YEARS WE HAVE BEGUN THE PROCESS OF REPAIRING SIDEWALKS THAT HAVE BEEN DAMAGED BY TOWNSHIP TREES BUT HAVE NOT BUDGETED ENOUGH TO MAKE AN IMPACT.

OPTIONS

- INCREASE FUNDING FOR TREE MAINTENANCE, REPLANTING AND SIDEWALK REPAIR IN RANGE OF \$3M PER YEAR.
- REPEAL § 263-9. Street trees RETURNING THE RESPONSIBILITY BACK TO THE PROPERTY OWNER FROM THE BACK OF CURB INWARD TO THE PROPERTY.
 - This would eliminate the bulk of the \$3M per year for the maintenance of street trees.
 - However, there still needs to be a significant funding towards Township trees residing in our parks, open space and parcels of land owned by Radnor Township.
