ORDINANCE NO. 2012-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 130-25.D. OF CHAPTER 130 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, RESCINDING THE PARKING REQUIREMENTS FOR WEST WAYNE AVENUE.

The Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby ORDAIN and ENACT the following:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 130-25.D. of Chapter 130 of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended repealing the existing two-hour parking on the south side of West Wayne Avenue in accordance with the following provision:

[West Wayne Avenue	South	2 Hours	From point 712 feet southeasterly of Welwyn Road to Maplewood Road]

<u>Section 2</u>. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

<u>Section 4.</u> Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of Radnor Township.
