ORDINANCE NO. 2011-07

AN ORDINANCE OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 104, SECTION 104-7, FALSE ALARMS, TO PROVIDE FOR A REVISED SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR MULTIPLE FALSE ALARMS PER CALENDAR YEAR.

Section 1. Chapter 104, Section 104-7, False Alarms, is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 104.7. False Alarms.

- A. For the purpose of defraying the cost to the Township for responding to false alarms, the owners and/or users of an alarm system as defined by this Chapter shall be subject to the following schedule of fines:
 - (1) For the second false alarm per calendar year: \$70.00 for each alarm.
 - (2) For the third and each subsequent false alarm per calendar year: \$140.00 for each alarm.
- B. The Board of Commissioners is hereby authorized on an annual basis to modify all false alarm fines by separate ordinance or resolution.
- Section 2. Repealer. All ordinance or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- **Section 3.** Severability. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Radnor Township Home Rule Charter.
