#### ORDINANCE 2010-16 RADNOR TOWNSHIP

AN ORDINANCE OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING PARKING METER ZONES, OFF-STREET PARKING METER AREAS, PARKING METER RATES, PARKING FINE PROCEDURES, AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

Section 1. § 130-26 E. of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended to add the following:

- E. Parking on permit basis only.
  - (1) The following area shall be set aside for the exclusive use of official parking permits, only. No person shall park a vehicle in the area and times specified below without displaying a valid parking permit and/or hangtag visible through the windshield of the vehicle.

- (2) Permits for Waynewood, Louella Park and Walk and Bellevue Park and Walk to be issued through the Community Development office of Radnor Township. Permits will be issued on a quarterly, bi-annual or annual basis.
- (3) Permits for Runnymede Avenue are to be issued by the Police Department and distributed by the Radnor School District.

Section 2. § 130-39 of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended to restate and establish the following parking meter zones:

# § 130-39. Parking meter zones established.

A. Parking meter zones are hereby established upon the highway or parts of highways described below, and parking or standing a vehicle in any parking meter space in such zones shall be lawful only upon deposit of the amount required for each specified period of time and only when not in excess of the maximum parking time indicated, on all days except Sundays and holidays. Hours in operation shall be 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

B. Off-street parking meter areas are hereby established as described below, and parking of a vehicle in such areas shall be subject to the same provisions as for on-highway parking meter zones.

C. The number of meters per location and the time limits per location may be revised and amended by separate Resolution upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.

Section 3. § 130-40 of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended as follows:

## § 130-40. Parking meter rates.

The charges for the zones established above shall be as follow:

- A. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of fifteen (15) minutes, the charge shall be twenty-five cents (\$0.25) in the form of one (1) U.S. quarter for fifteen (15) minutes maximum.
- B. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of two (2) hours, the charge shall be twenty-five cents (\$0.25) in the form of one (1) U.S. quarter for each thirty (30) minutes for two (2) hours maximum.
- C. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of five (5) hours, the charge shall be twenty-five cents (\$0.25) in the form of one (1) U.S. quarter for each thirty (30) minutes for five (5) hours maximum.
- D. In parking meter spaces with a time limit of ten (10) hours, the charge shall be twenty-five cents (\$0.25) in the form of one (1) U.S. quarter for each thirty (30) minutes for ten (10) hours maximum.

Section 4. § 130-44.C. of Chapter 130 of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended as follows:

- C. Parking Fines and Procedures.
  - (1) Parking Fines.

All violations are payable within five (5) days.

#### COINS NOT ACCEPTED.

- Payment procedure. Any person who receives notice of a violation under Section C. shall pay the penalty imposed for such violation within five (5) days after the date of such notice. Payment for violations shall be made by mailing the ticket along with a check or money order in the amount specified on the ticket or payment may be made at the Radnor Township Municipal Building.
- (3) Late fee procedure. If Radnor Township has not received payment for a violation within five (5) days after the date of violation, a late fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) in addition to the fine will be assessed. Failing to pay this fine and/or late fee within thirty days (30) of

the violation will result in the issuance of a summons and prosecution before a District Judge.

- (4) Procedure to contest violation. Any person who wishes to contest a violation under this Chapter shall contact the Office of the District Judge.
- D. A notice of violation of any provision of § 130-20 through § 130-27 §130-28 through § 130-31 or §130-35A, B, C, or F of this Chapter shall be placed on the vehicle parked in violation, such notice to contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle that, if he shall report to the Police Department of the Township of Radnor and pay the penalty imposed for such violation within five (5) days after the time of such notice, or if he shall place such sum within the envelope provided and mail it to the township within such time limit, the same shall save the violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine and costs regulated in Section 130-40 B and C(3).

<u>Section 5.</u> Repealer. All ordinance or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

<u>Section 7.</u> Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Radnor Township Home Rule Charter.
