A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE INTERMUNICIPAL LIQUOR LICENSE TRANSFER APPLICATION OF GIANT FOOD STORES, LLC PURSUANT TO THE CODE OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is authorized, pursuant to 43 P.S. 461 of the Pennsylvania Liquor Code as amended to approve the intermunicipal transfer of liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, Giant Food Stores, LLC ("Applicant") has proposed the transfer of restaurant Liquor License No. E-4912 from Denny's, Inc., 5321 Baltimore Pike, Clifton Heights, PA, 19018 to Giant Food Stores, LLC, 550 E. Lancaster Avenue, Wayne, Radnor Township, Pennsylvania 19087; and

WHEREAS, the Board has conducted a public hearing on Applicant's request on August 17, 2015; and

WHEREAS, after considering all of the testimony and public comment presented at the hearing the Board has determined that the requested transfer will not adversely affect the welfare, health or peace of Radnor Township, provided that certain terms and conditions are met.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby approve the application of Giant Food Stores, LLC to transfer Liquor License No. E-4912 to 550 E. Lancaster Avenue, Wayne, Radnor Township, Delaware County, Pennsylvania subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That there is no outdoor seating in connection with the restaurant and/or beer sales.
- 2. That there is no outside amplified music.
- 3. That the Applicant comply with all the terms and conditions of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board for the liquor license transfer.
- 4. That the Applicant submit its building renovation plans to the Department of Community Development and that the Applicant comply with all other applicable building and/or zoning requirements.
- 5. That the Applicant obtain written approval of the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners prior to any proposed transfer of the license to another location within Radnor Township.

6. The proposed new eating place will be limited to the following hours of operation:

Monday – Saturday 7:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Sunday 9:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m.
