A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR PROFESSIONAL DEER CULLING

WHEREAS, Radnor Township established a Deer Mitigation Program through Resolution No. 2012-76 to provide for the control of deer density through education, private hunting and professional culling; and

WHEREAS, Radnor Township promotes legal and permitted hunting activities on privately held land and on designated township properties in Radnor during hunting season in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to enter into a contract for professional deer culling with the U.S.D.A.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners does hereby approve a contract with the U.S. Department of Agriculture to manage the deer population for the 2014-2015 season to include a sharpshooting program as outlined in the White-tailed Deer Management Plan for Radnor Township approved by the U.S. Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service and Wildlife Services in April 2012. This contract will cover a fifteen (15) night removal program and include deer removal and carcass delivery to processor in an amount not to exceed \$ 72,757.11.
