

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-02

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE DELAWARE COUNTY 2011 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Township of Radnor, Delaware County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Radnor acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Delaware County Planning Department and the Delaware County Department of Emergency Services in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of Radnor Township, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Delaware County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and


WHEREAS, the Delaware County 2011 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by Board of Commissioners of the Township of Radnor:
