A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROMOTING VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION FOR RESIDENTS AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN TRAP-NEUTER-RETURN PROGRAMS AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY TO CONTROL THE STRAY POPULATION OF CATS AND DOGS.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby **RESOLVED** that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners does hereby advocate and promote voluntary participation in Trap-Neuter-Return procedures and will make township resources available to residents and/or non-profit organizations to assist them in facilitating TNR activities.
