A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE RADNOR TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Radnor Township Police Department is seeking to replace two of its vehicles currently being utilized by its patrol units; and

WHEREAS, the replace vehicles consist of one (1) 2012 Ford Expedition XL and one (1) 2013 Ford Utility Police Interceptor Base;


WHEREAS, the replacement vehicles will be purchased under Pennsylvania's COSTARS Program for \$79,836.98 which includes the cost of the vehicles at \$62,945.57 and the estimated cost to equip the vehicles at \$16,891.41, and

WHEREAS, the replacement vehicles will be purchased and outfitted using funds allocated by the Board of Commissioners pursuant to the excess fund balance reallocation as detailed in Resolution 2012-88.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* and *ENACTED* that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners does hereby approve the purchase of two (2) new vehicles for use by the Radnor Township Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$79,836.98.
