**A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF AMMUNITION TO BE
USED IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S WEAPONS**

WHEREAS, The Radnor Township Police Department requires ammunition to be expended during normal operations; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the minimum amount of ammunition need to maintain police operations in 2011 is eleven cases of 5.56 mm 55 grain GDSP ammunition to be used in the patrol rifles and 11 cases of .40 caliber S&W 165 grain GDHP; and


WHEREAS, Markl Supply Company is listed to provide the ammunition under State contract through COSTARS (Cooperative Sourcing To Achieve Reductions in Spend-Pennsylvania's Cooperative Purchasing program) for a total cost of \$6,324.67, and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners does hereby approve the purchase of ammunition from Markyl Supply Company in an amount not to exceed \$6, 324.67.
