

**ORDINANCE # 2009-02**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN GULPH CREEK RD. TO SERVE SEVEN PROPERTIES IN THAT AREA, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF THE COST UPON THE BENEFITING PROPERTY OWNERS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Radnor does **ENACT** and **ORDAIN**:

Section 1. That the Township construct, in accordance with plans prepared by Radnor Township sanitary sewers in the area described below.

The project begins in the IN THE REAR OF 202 Gulph Creek Rd., thence extending easterly and parallel to Gulph Creek Rd. for a distance of approximately 800 feet to the existing pumping station at Hermitage Dr.

Section 2. Upon completion of the project the Township Engineer shall approve the assessment chargeable to each property owner benefited or accommodated by the sewer using the Equal Distribution of Benefit Method.

Section 3. The total cost of the construction, engineering, inspections, and all other related costs shall be assessed against the properties benefited and/or accommodated by the sewer. The assessments shall be payable in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9 of the Code of the Township of Radnor.
