- IV. Old Business:
 - a. Discussed adding vaping ban to the Radnor Clean indoor act. Recommend adding a definition change of language to current act to include vaping devices.
 - b. Student projects are in draft form. Survey questions need review by school officials. They reviews will occur after winter break by Administration and guidance staff at RHS.
- V. New Business:
 - A. Rosemary Hall from the League of Women Voters, gave a presentation from the Public Health Committee of the LWV. The consensus study was drafted to propose forming a Delaware County Health Department. Study began in 2007 with current activity of holding public forums to discuss study. The upcoming dates for public forums are posted on the Radnor Township and Delaware County websites. The LWV would like the BOH to support the John Hopkins report from 2010 and supporting Delaware County to perform a feasibility study.

Kathy Wright commented on the surrounding area hospitals need for data sharing throughout Delaware county.
