Construct swimming pool 120 CY of dirt (keep on site)

Revised plans were shown which shifted the pool to the North Tree protection fence needs to be brought to Code – 6' chain link fence Revise plans and submit to Engineering

511 Maplewood Avenue GP 14-39 Approved Construct swimming pool 50 CY of dirt (keep on site) Remove (5) trees – 0 replacements required

There will be no grading beyond the limit of disturbance

500 Chaumont Drive GP 14-40 Conditional Approval Construct swimming pool 140 CY of dirt (take off site)

Remove (2) trees – 0 replacements required

Remove (2) trees 30" and 42" – 12 trees required (8) being large canopy trees

The limit of disturbance cannot be moved

There will be no grading beyond the limit of disturbance

Tree protection fence shall be one continuous line, not arched around trees Show the location of the stock pile on the plans

Show tree protection fence around the 42" Oak

Applicant's arborist to submit a report on the 30" and 42" tree

Township Arborist to verify tree report

Location of replacement trees to be determined by anticipated canopy

Note location of replacement trees on plans

Tree "A" must be mitigated through replanting and documented on the plans Revise plans and submit to Engineering
