



RADNOR TOWNSHIP SHADE TREE COMMISSION MEETING SUMMARY

February 27, 2013

The comments noted below are the Shade Tree Commission's views only. Clearing and Grading Permits are issued by the Engineering Department, which reviews plans AFTER approval by the Shade Tree Commission.

The commission was called to order at 7:30 PM. Those in attendance were: Howard Holden, Chair; Jim Ward, Vice Chair; Jack Millerick; Doug McCone; Jim Schwartz; Stephen Norcini, P.E., Director of Public Works; and Suzan Jones, Administrative Assistant. Chair Howard Holden presided over the meeting.

Mr. Holden announced that the Board of Commissioners adopted the revised Shade Tree Ordinance. It will take effect on March 11, 2013.

Plans Requiring Shade Tree Review

744 Cornerstone La GP 13-07 Approved Construct a SFD Move 400 CY of dirt off vacant lot (take off site)

The applicant was advised to remove the 12" Maple as it may be affected during the construction. Applicant will plant 1 large canopy tree on site to replace the Maple.

746 Cornerstone La GP 13-10 Conditional Approval Construct a SFD Move 400 CY of dirt off vacant lot (take off site)

Redirect the utilities on an angle and move as far away as possible from the 14" Cherry Relocate the stock pile away from any tree and beyond the limit of disturbance Relocate the yard inlet box further west away from the Maple and Cherry trees Show tree protection fence in areas of all trees

Cut roots of all trees in construction areas and deep root fertilize, etc. to help preservation Submit plans to Engineering showing all revisions noted herein

115 Ashwood Rd C 13-01 No show - tabled 42" White Ash Want tree removed to create play area for children

737 S Roberts Rd C 13-02 Conditional Approval

Removed 6 trees without approval

Applicant will plant 12 large canopy trees from the revised shade tree ordinance Utilize new ordinance for recommended tree list Provide a letter from arborist stating species and size of trees Establish an escrow for the replacement trees Engineering Dept. will inspect when plantings begin Escrow to be returned after proof of plantings

502 Heather Cir C 13-03 Approved

Remove 1 large White Pine – greater than 36"

Applicant will plant 3 large canopy trees from the revised shade tree ordinance Larch trees were suggested

Neighbor to be informed of project and copy letter to township regarding impact on trees Establish an escrow for the replacement trees

654 Malin Rd GP11-147 Conditional Approval

Construct addition and deck

Remove 6 trees

Applicant will plant 6 trees

Identify neighbor's Maple trees

Township arborist to verify impact on neighbor's trees

Arborist's recommendations to be followed and noted

Suggests reducing width of parking area of driveway by two feet

Slide stormwater mgmt. system up towards existing driveway

Neighbor to be informed of project and copy letter to township regarding impact on trees

Return to March meeting with all documents and reports

All reports to be submitted to members for review – decision to return will be made at that time

748 Newtown Rd GP13-14 Conditional Approval

Demolish existing SFD

Construct new SFD, patios, drives, etc.

Move 825 CY (take off site)

Remove 11 trees

Applicant will plant 28 trees

Grading should be modified in areas to avoid impact on neighbor's trees

Neighbor to be informed of project and copy letter to township regarding impact on trees

Manhole to be moved closer to center of stormwater system
Install fencing to prohibit traffic on right hand side of house
Stormwater piping on left side of house to be moved closer to house and away from neighbors
Tree protection fence to be adequate – super silt fence is suggested
Township arborist to check all trees on shared property lines – submit report and recommendations
Trees on left side - 42", 47" and 37"
Trees on right side – 27" and 28 "

225 Ashwood Rd GP 13-20 Conditional Approval Remove existing driveway Construct SFD Move 700 CY of dirt (keep on site)

Applicant was requested to plant large canopy trees

Agnes Irwin School Larch 16" Willow 24" Approved by twp. arborist

Imprelis Herbicide damage / In decline

209 Atlee Rd Prunus sp. 44" Approved by twp. arborist

Lateral root decay/trunk decay/in decline

208 Bloomingdale Ave Fraxinus, sp Approved by twp. arborist

Large decay area/declined beyond recovery

323 West Ave Norway Maple Approved by twp. arborist

Previous storm damage resulting in loss of a major leader

Areas of decay throughout the main trunk

204 Wyndom La 31/2" Ash 31.3" Ash Approved by twp. arborist Substantial decay in root plates & buttress roots Homeowner feels the trees are risks Accurate dbh 29 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ " respectively - No permit or authorization required
