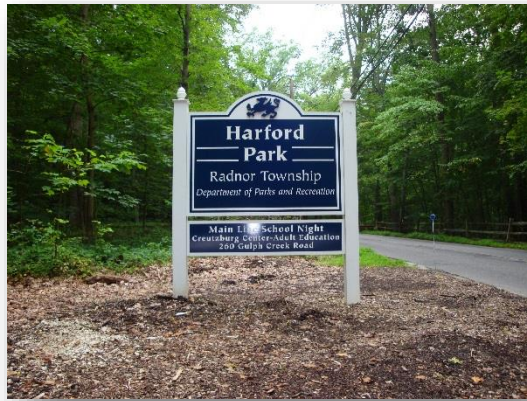


Radnor Township 2019 Arbor Day Celebration
