To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to inform you about the **44th Annual Penn Medicine Radnor Run Event** that will take place on **Sunday, October 31, 2021** (there is no scheduled rain date for the event). This event is a 5-mile foot race, 2-mile trail walk, and 1/2-mile kids fun run that has been a great Main Line tradition for 44 years and benefits the American Lung Association. **This event will pose significant traffic delays in the areas on and surrounding the course from approximately 7:30 AM to 11:00 AM on Sunday, October 31.** Please post or distribute this information within your organization as you see fit. If you would like additional copies of this letter or any enclosures, please let me know and I'm happy to provide them.

Please see enclosed map of the 5-mile race course. The course begins and ends at the Radnor Township Building at 301 Iven Avenue. Iven Avenue will be closed from Radnor Crossing Apartments to Conestoga Road (only local traffic will be let through at times that are safe and when large groups of participants are not on the street). 5-mile course runners will travel down Iven Avenue, crossing Conestoga Road onto Church Road and continue on Church Road until it becomes Brooke Road. After winding down to the end of Brooke Road, participants will turn left onto Darby-Paoli Road before turning right into the Willows. The course goes through the Willows Park and back to Darby-Paoli Road where participants will turn right before turning left onto Newtown Road. Participants will travel up Newtown Road, turn left on to Abrahams Lane and will continue on to Lesley Road where they will turn right. Upon reaching Parkes Run Lane, runners will turn left and go back to Abrahams Lane where they will turn right making their way to Church Road and turning right. Crossing Conestoga Road, runners will make their way down Aberdeen Avenue, turning right on to Orchard Way and again on to Brookside Avenue. Finally, runners will turn left onto Iven Avenue and head for the finish line passing the Radnor Township Building and ending at Encke Park. 2-mile course participants will travel along Creek Drive, past the Radnor Crossing Apartments, and onto the Radnor Trail. Participants will hit a turnaround point on the Radnor Trail and then travel back to the start/finish line along Creek Drive.

Radnor Police and volunteer course marshals will be handling traffic and safety concerns as runners pass through each section of the course. Please use caution and allow extra time for travel. **There will be significant traffic delays in the areas surrounding the course and at the Township Building.**

The race begins at 8:30 AM. Staff, volunteers, and participants will arrive earlier at the Radnor Township Building for set up and preparations. We estimate that the race should be over by 11:00 AM and all event activities to be completed by approximately 12:00 PM. We are expecting over 500 participants in the Radnor Run this year.

Thank you for taking the time to review this information and I hope this notice helps to inform you in advance about the traffic implications.
