

RESOLUTION 2022-40

A RESOLUTION OF THE RADNOR TOWNSHIP BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ENGAGING THE COHEN LAW GROUP TO NEGOTIATE WITH VERIZON WITH RESPECT TO THE TOWNSHIP FRANCHISE AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$36,500.

WHEREAS, the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners recognizes the expiration of the current Verizon Franchise Agreement as of September 25, 2021 and the need for agreement negotiation and renewal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners requests that Cohen Law Group consults with Citizens Communication Council throughout the negotiation of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Cohen Law Group successfully negotiated the renewal of the Comcast Franchise Agreement via Ordinance 2020-21 adopted on November 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Cohen Law Group has submitted a proposal to assist the Township with the Verizon Franchise Agreement renewal; and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioner engage the Cohen Law Group to work with the Citizens Communications Counsel and assist Radnor Township in the completion of cable franchise renewal negotiations with Verizon, in an amount not to exceed \$36,500 to complete all Verizon negotiations.
