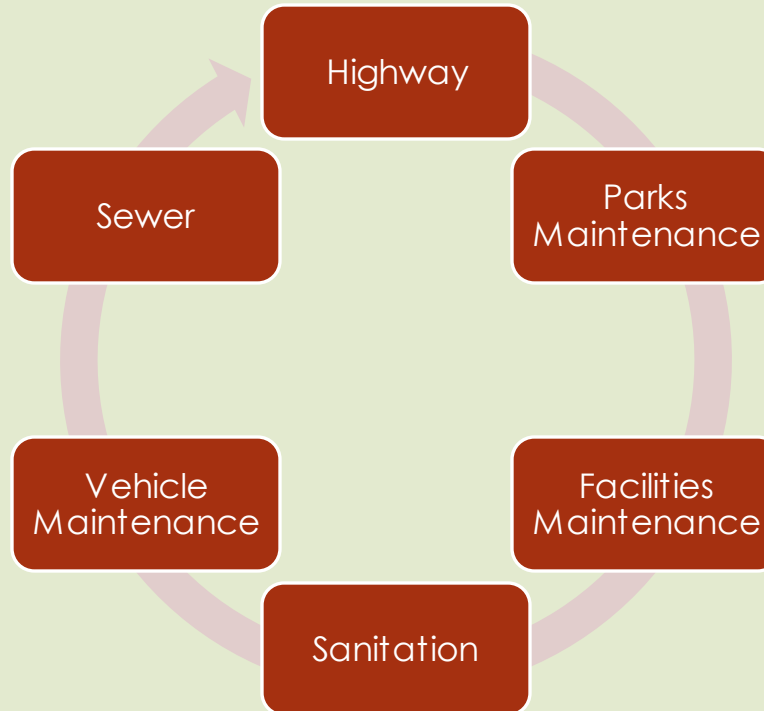

The divisions of Public Works are not stand-alone groups; all divisions interact and assist each other as needed. This is evident in snow plowing operations, leaf collection efforts, trash collection, sewer repairs, and the care of our Township parks and facilities.

Sanitation Division



- The sanitation division has 22 hardworking employees
- Making up 7 routes
- Providing service to over 8,000 residences each week

Sanitation Services

- 1000 Bulk pick ups in 2021
- 600 Rear Yard Trash & Recycling Pickups Weekly
- Over 4,000 Ton of Yard Waste Collected in 2021
- Roadside Debris and Trash Cleanup Weekly
- Empty Trash Cans in the Wayne Business District and Along Lancaster Pike – 5 days a week
- Recycling collected each week – approximately 56 Tons
- Trash Collected each week – approximately 140 Tons

Highway Division

The Highway and Streets Division has 11 hardworking employees





Highway Services

- Storm Sewer Maintenance 1,800 inlets, 57 miles of storm sewer
- Storm sewer inlet & pipe repair
- Inlet grate cleaning prior to and after storm.
- Curb repair/installation
- Pothole repair & patching
- Sweep all township streets 3 times each year & sweep Wayne Business District monthly
- Maintain all regulatory (speed limit, stop signs, speed humps, etc.) in the Township, - 8,000 signs
- Paint all intersection pavement markings - Using 200 gallons of paint annually

Parks Maintenance Division

The Parks Maintenance department has 12 hardworking employees





Parks Maintenance Services

- Maintains 12 baseball/softball fields
- Maintains 5 tennis courts and 5 basketball courts
- Maintains 26 parks throughout the township including tot-lots and bathrooms
- Maintains 80 picnic tables, 115 park benches, and 100 trash cans requiring 50 gallons of paint and replacing rotted and broken boards
- Maintains 5 miles of hiking trails
- Roadside mowing of township roads
- Removes fallen trees blocking creeks & streams
- Mulch and woodchip all beds using 750 yards
- Mows approx. 200 acres of grass 5 days a week – April through October

Sanitary Sewer Division

The Sanitary Sewer Department has 3 hardworking employees:



Sanitary Sewer Services

- ▶ Performs PA One Call Mark Outs – 5,542 in 2021
- ▶ On-Call 24 hours a day to respond to after hour sewer emergencies
- ▶ Televises storm & sanitary lines for conditions
- ▶ Maintains 205 miles of sanitary sewer lines

Vehicle Maintenance



Vehicle (Fleet) Maintenance Division consists of 3 heavy duty, diesel, motorcycle, and automotive technicians responsible for the following duties:

- Maintenance and Repairs to 130 + Township vehicles and equipment including loaders, leaf vacs, mowers, the tub grinder, sewer and snow removal equipment
- Monitors and orders all fuels and solvents for Township vehicle requirements including the Radnor Fire Dept.
- Performs pa state inspections on all township vehicles and trailers
- Performs roadside assistance on trash trucks and township vehicles

Facilities Maintenance

All of the Public Works Divisions share in the responsibility for the upkeep and routine maintenance of the Radnor Township Municipal Building, the Radnor Township Public Works Facility, the Wayne Senior Center, the Radnor Memorial Library, the Radnor Activity Center at Sulpizio Gym, The Creutzburg center, and the Willows Cottage
