✓ Updating the Patrol Vehicle Fleet

Purchase of new vehicles and all necessary equipment to maintain the patrol vehicles available to daily service.

✓ Indoor Range

Repair the existing indoor range and make it available for training and re-certification of personnel. The range has been out of service since 2019.

✓ Mobile In-Car Computer Terminals

Replace all in car computers for the patrol division. Update to latest hardware and software to assist Officers while working in the field.

✓ License Plate Readers

Install and maintain several license plate readers through out the Township to assist with crime enforcement and criminal apprehension.
