







Original Concept Natural Lands (2017)






Darby Paoli Trail Radnor Township, Delaware County

Includes:

- 2,200' paved trail
- 2,786' mowed trail
- New parking area
- New bridge
- Culvert crossings



Estimated 2024 construction cost: \$1.21 M










Section 2: Skunk Hollow Area Sawmill Road to Darby Paoli Road

Includes:

- 1,798' paved trail
- Improved parking area
- New bridge
- Culvert extension for trail
- Boardwalk to avoid wetlands



Estimated 2024 construction cost: \$ 1.82M










Sections 3 and 4:

Darby Paoli Road to Willows Road Willows Trail Spur

Unpaved Rye Field Path (Section 7) & Quarry/Riparian Trails (Section 6)

Includes:

- 3,003' paved trail
- Two mowed trails 2,020' & 4,266'
- Culvert crossings



Estimated 2024 construction cost: \$ 2 M





- Engineering Plans Complete (pending comments, permitting, and grant requirements)
- 110 Engineering Plan Sheets with details, calculations, and permit application forms
- Infiltration Testing to be completed (schedule determined by farming)

Regulatory Permitting:

- PaDEP Joint Permit required for bridges, culverts.
 - Wetland impacts have been avoided.
- Delaware County Conservation District NPDES Permit for Stormwater and Erosion & Sediment Control
- PennDOT Highway Occupancy Permits
