ORDINANCE NO. 2023-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF RADNOR, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 270, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 270-10 PROHIBITED RIGHT TURNS ON A RED SIGNAL, SECTION 270-11, PROHIBITED TURNS AT INTERSECTIONS, AND SECTION 270-16 STOP INTERSECTIONS.

The Board of Commissioners of the Township of Radnor does hereby ENACT and ORDAIN, as follows:

Section 1. Section 270-10, Prohibited Right Turns on a Red Signal, is hereby amended prohibiting any person from making a right turn (or a left turn from a one-way street into another one-way street) when facing a steady red signal at any of the locations described below.

Section 2. Section 270-11, Prohibited Turns at Intersections, of the Code of the Township of Radnor is hereby amended, prohibiting any driver of a vehicle to make a turn other than the kind designated at any of the following intersection(s):

Section 3. Section 270-16, Stop Intersections, is hereby amended as follows:

Stop Sign On	Direction of Travel	Stop Sign On
Eagle Road	East	Beechtree Lane
Eagle Road	West	Beechtree Lane

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the Home Rule Charter of Radnor Township.
