A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) NEW ELECTRIC VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE RADNOR TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR \$145,792.00

WHEREAS, In accordance with Resolution 2021-32, Adopting the Renewable Energy and Conservation Plan dated February 2021, the Radnor Township Police Department is seeking to purchase two (2) electric vehicles to be utilized by its Patrol and Administration Divisions; and

WHEREAS, Radnor Township was awarded a Local Share Account Grant through the Commonwealth Financing Authority in the amount of \$400,000 for the purchase and installation of EV charging stations and purchase of Electric Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the new electric vehicles will be funded under by the Local Share Account Grant ; and

WHEREAS, the new vehicles consist of two (2) F-150 Lightning (AWD) SuperCrew Cab all electric vehicles, and;


WHEREAS, the new electric vehicles will be purchased under the Local Share Account Grant for \$145,792.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners does hereby approve the purchase of two (2) new electric vehicles for use by the Radnor Township Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$145,792.00.


