

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-06

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR WHITE TAIL DEER AND CANADIAN GOOSE MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Radnor Township Police Department is seeking to enter into a service agreement with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to conduct White Tail Deer and Canadian Goose Management; and

WHEREAS, deer culling and goose management will be conducted by the USDA at a cost of \$50,521.95; and

WHEREAS, deer processing will be completed at a cost of \$20,250; and

WHEREAS, the Management Program will be funded under the 2024 Capital Budget at a total cost of \$70,771.95.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* that the Radnor Township Board of Commissioners does hereby approve a service agreement with the USDA for White Tail Deer mitigation and Canadian Goose Management in an amount not to exceed \$70,771.95.


