August 2024

Theft of Phone - 550 E. Lancaster Av. - Homesense Store

The victim had their cell phone stolen on 8/13/2024 at approximately 7:45 PM, while shopping at the Homesense, 550 E. Lancaster Av. The phone was stolen from their purse while they were shopping.

Package Thefts - Various Apartment Complexes - Radnor Township

On Tuesday, 8/27/2024, several packages were reported stolen after being delivered to residents. These thefts occurred from residents living in different apartment complexes in the Township.

Criminal Mischief to Auto - 200 block of Brook St.

Sometime over night, between 8/31/2024 and 9/1/2024 a vehicle was damaged while parked in the 200 block of Brook St. The vehicle, which belongs to a resident of Brook St., had its front passenger window smashed. At this time nothing appears to have been stolen from the car.

The Radnor Police respects citizens' privacy, civil rights, and civil liberties by emphasizing behavior, rather than appearance, in identifying suspicious activity. Factors such as race, ethnicity, and/or religious affiliation are not suspicious. The public should only report suspicious behavior and situations (e.g., an unattended backpack or package, or someone breaking into a vehicle or restricted area). Moreover, any physical descriptions are based on victim and witness statements provided to the Radnor Police at the time the incident was reported or developed through investigation

On Monday, August 12, 2024 the Haverford Township Police Department responded to the 2000 block of West Chester Pike for a road rage shooting incident.
