## A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR THE

EMERGENCY REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT E. LANCASTER AVENUE AND N. ABERDEEN AVENUE TO CHARLES A. HIGGINS & SONS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$115,000 TO BE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUND

WHEREAS, the traffic signal at the intersection of E. Lancaster Avenue and N. Aberdeen Avenue was severely damaged during a vehicle collision on July 12, 2024;

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Emergency Repair procedures stipulated in the Township Code, the Township Manager and Finance Director were notified of the situation;

WHEREAS, an emergency repair was completed and a temporary replacement signal was installed;

WHEREAS, an easement and PennDOT Traffic Signal approval must be obtained in order to install a permanent replacement signal; and

WHEREAS, Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc., which provides regular Radnor Township traffic signal maintenance, has initiated the emergency work and provided a tentative proposal to install the permanent replacement;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby Authorize Payment for the Emergency Repair and Replacement of the Traffic Signal at E. Lancaster Avenue and N. Aberdeen Avenue to Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc. in an Amount Not To Exceed \$115,000 to be Paid from the General Fund.
