

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-128

A RESOLUTION OF RADNOR TOWNSHIP, DELAWARE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT FOR EMERGENCY TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROL REPAIRS AT LANCASTER AVENUE AND LOWRYS LANE TO CHARLES HIGGINS & SONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$38,976.20

WHEREAS, the control cabinet and controllers for the traffic signal at the intersection of Lowrys Lane and Lancaster Avenue were damaged during during a vehicle accident on September 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Emergency Repair procedures stipulated in the Township Code, the Township Manager and Finance Director were notified of the situation; and


WHEREAS, Charles Higgins & Sons, the Township's contractor responsible for the maintenance and repairs to traffic signals, responded to the emergency and installed a new cabinet and control system for this very important roadway intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Township has filed an insurance claim against the motorist responsible for the damage to seek reimbursement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it *RESOLVED* the Board of Commissioners of Radnor Township does hereby approve the emergency expenditure of \$38,976.20 to Charles A. Higgins & Sons, Inc. for the traffic signal control repair and replacement at Lowrys Lane and Lancaster Avenue
