9-1-1 RESPONSES and CALLS FOR SERVICE

- **43 Officers/1 Superintendent.**
 - Patrol Unit – 30 Officers
 - Detective Unit – 4 Detectives
 - Highway Unit – 3 Officers
 - Administration – 7 Officers
- **3 Civilian Administrative Employees**



Emergency Operations Center EOC

- **Multi-Functional, Multi-Hazard approach to Emergency Management**
- **Incorporates all Township Departments and Services**
 - **Natural Disasters – i.e. Hurricanes, Snow Storms**
 - **Large Scale Events – i.e. Papal Visit, NCAA Championship**



9-1-1 RESPONSES and CALLS FOR SERVICE

- Patrol Division is the “Backbone” of the Department - 30 Officers Assigned to Patrol
- Patrol Handles all Calls for Service
- As Documented in the Township Manager’s Monthly Report:
 - 2017 (to date) ... 18,107
 - 2016 23,173
 - 2015 21,806



Vacant House Checks

- **Conducted by Patrol Sector Officers on a Daily Basis**
- **Random Checks of Registered Vacant Houses within the Township**
- **General and Specific Deterrent to Reduce Residential Burglaries**



School Visits

- Conducted on a Daily Basis by Patrol Sector Officers
- Officers Conduct Walk-Throughs of all Public and Private Schools
- Provides the Opportunity for Officers to familiarize themselves with Staff, Students and Building Layout



Bank/Financial Security Checks

- Conducted by Patrol Officers on a Daily Basis
- Random Foot Patrols of Each Financial Institution
- General Deterrent for Bank Robberies and Fraudulent Activities



Business Security Checks

- Conducted by Patrol Sector Officers on a Nightly Basis
- Check for Secured Businesses – Business Owners are Notified of Security Issues
- General and Specific Deterrent to Reduce Commercial Burglaries



Community Contacts/Victim Follow-Ups

- Police Follow Up With Crime Victims
- Community Relations Contact
- Tremendous Positive Feedback





Special Projects



- **Accreditation**

- Complete review and updating of policy manual to meet Pennsylvania accreditation standards
- Will increase public's confidence in the professionalism and competence of the Department after achieving industry established best practices in all areas of operations

- **Integrity Control**

- Thorough investigation of all complaints involving the Police Department
- Review all officer activity as part of early warning system for potential problems
- Manage the random drug and alcohol testing program

- Meet monthly with the Radnor Community on Traffic Safety Issues
- Red Light Enforcement
- Stop Sign Enforcement
- School Bus Enforcement



PARKING AUTHORITY



- 3 Part-time Meter Enforcement Officers
- Enforce Over 900 Parking Spaces In The Township
- Enforcement Of 2 Hour And Permit Parking Throughout The Township
- Issued 13,927 Parking Violations In 2016
- Collection And Maintenance Of Parking Kiosks'
- 9 Crossing Guards

PARKING KIOSKS



- 44 “Pay by Space” kiosks strategically placed throughout the Township
- Machines accepts coins, bills, and credit cards
- Collection twice weekly

Animal Control Services

- Processing Deer Complaints/Deer Culling
- Processing Missing Dog/Cat Complaints
- Investigation of Dog and Cat Bites
- Liaison with Board of Health and Local Vets
- Control/Removal of Dangerous Animals



Detective Bureau

- Conduct Criminal Investigations
 - Bernie Robbins Robbery
- Conduct Background Investigations
- Liaison with District Attorney's Office
- Cyber Forensics Investigations
- Processing of Court Ordered Expungements

- **Coordination of Press/Media Relations for Serious Crimes and Alerts**

INTEGRATED PLATFORM FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT

Narcotics – Drug Task Force

- Investigations involve the distribution of Marijuana, Hash Oil, Cocaine, Prescription Medication
- Thirteen subjects arrested with Charges Ranging from Delivery to Possession of controlled substance(s)
- Three vehicles seized and \$861.00 in U.S. Currency seized
- Thirteen Heroin involved incidents
- Six usages of Naloxone
- One overdose death



S.W.A.T.

- **Selection and Coordination of Officers Serving on Regional SWAT Unit**
- **Supervision and Management of Training Events for SWAT Officers**
- **Management of Equipment Used by SWAT Officers**



Radnor Police Citizen's Police Academy

- Police Department manages a 9-week citizen training program (New Class 2018-04 is planned)
- This program greatly increases citizen knowledge of the Radnor Police
